

VARIETY Viura.

TYPE OF SOIL Poor, with a calcareous-clay composition.

BUSH VINES Small parcels located in Baños de Ebro.

CULTIVATION Organic in the process of certification with biodynamic practices and animal traction.

YIELDS 3,500 kg per hectare.

VINTAGE Temperate and dry. The winter was wet and mild. The December and January rain and snow provided a good water reserve which was much needed by the plants as it did not significantly rain again until June. The start of spring, which was warm and dry, allowed the plants to bud a week earlier than usual and continue flowering and setting without difficulties In June, summer storms added nearly 100 mm of precipitation in that month alone to refresh the vines. The rest of the summer was cool without much water, thus limiting yields. It rained again in early September, which brought relief from the summer drought before harvest on 20th September, resulting in grapes with excellent concentration and balance.

WINEMAKING Alcoholic fermentation with native yeasts in 228 French oak barrels.

AGED 20 months in French oak barrels.

PRODUCTION 4,106 bottles and 90 magnums.
